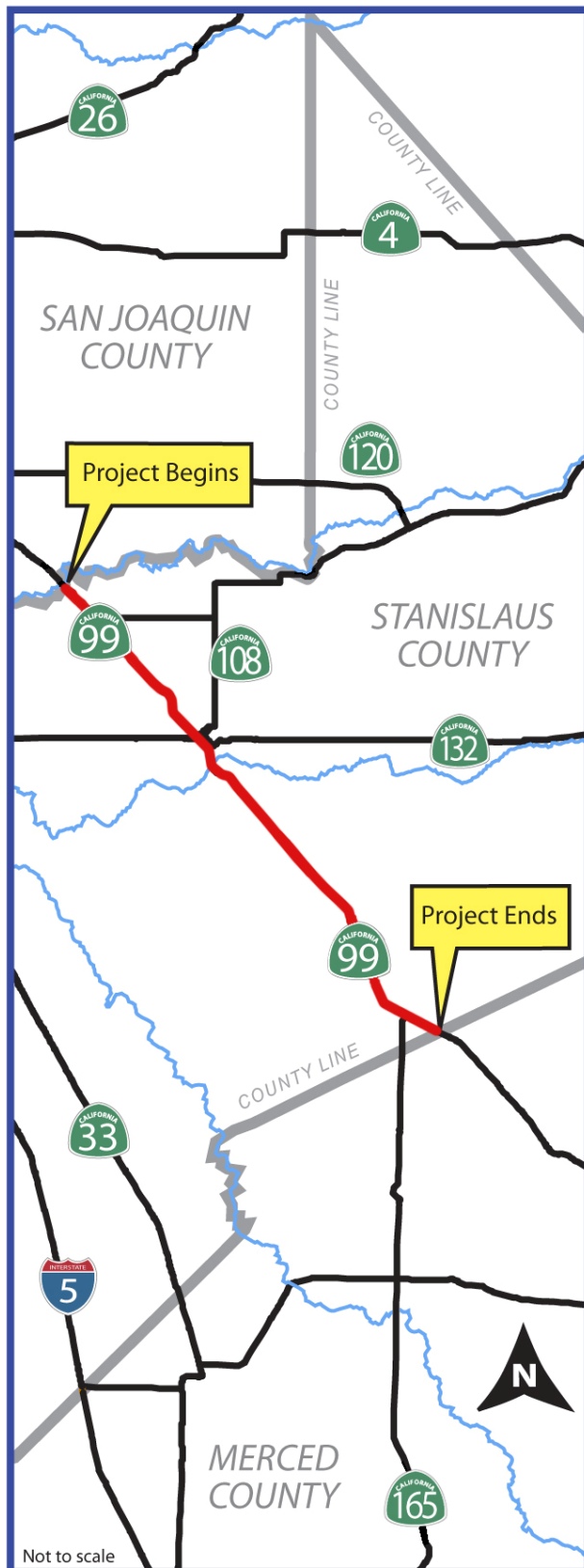


# STATE ROUTE 99 RESURFACING AND RESTORATION PROJECT

(Stanislaus County)



## The Project

The California Department of Transportation will resurface and restore approximately 25 miles of the existing pavement on State Route 99 in Stanislaus County from the San Joaquin County line to the Merced County line. This project will replace the pavement utilizing three different strategies:

- Replacement of the existing base and pavement with new concrete pavement;
- Concrete slab replacement;
- Crack-seal and overlay the existing pavement with new asphalt concrete.

The project will also include installing shoulder rumble strips on the inside and outside medians, fog sealing, re-striping the roadway, and replacing pavement markers. This \$95 Million project is funded by the State Highway Operation and Protection Program. The project will go to construction in the Spring of 2012, with completion in the Summer of 2014.
