Mr. Aljabiry:

The Stanislaus Council of Governments (StanCOG) Policy Board has authorized its Executive Director to approve Administrative Modification #11 to StanCOG's 2011 FTIP. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, FHWA and the FTA that an administrative modification has been authorized and approved. A summary of changes to projects listed in the 2011 FTIP is attached as well as each project's corresponding CTIPS page. Our next FTIP formal amendment will update the financial plan to reflect the actual funding to support the added programming capacity.

StanCOG certifies that these projects are not included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Modifications included in this Administrative Modification meet the criteria identified in the letter issued by FHWA on November 17, 2008, regarding revised Federal/Statewide Transportation Improvement Program Modification Procedures. Per these "Procedures", StanCOG is issuing "minor" changes related to project cost, selection or programming that do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved Transportation Control Measure (TCM) project. None of the project modifications within this amendment require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis. Administrative Modifications to the FTIP used in lieu of Formal Amendments are not subject to FHWA approval.

Administrative Modification #11 modifies the following projects:

**Stanislaus Council of Governments:**

- **CTIPS # 114-0000-0022: SR 132 Expressway**

**Reduce: \$560,000 in CON Federal Funds in FFY 10/11**

**Add: \$700,000 to PE in FFY 09/10** (\$560,000 Federal Funds & \$140,000 in Local Funds)

This Administrative Modification is in accord with Caltrans' Administrative Modification policy as the funding modification does not exceed 25% of total project cost or \$5,000,000 for a single modification. All changes contained within do not modify the region's financial constraint.
