**RESOLUTION 06-53**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING CONCURRENCE FOR THE TRANSPORTATION CONTROL MEASURE (TCM) SUBSTITUTION: STANISLAUS COUNTY – EXISTING RIVER ROAD BICYCLE PROJECT AND SUBSTITUTE GRAYSON ROAD BIKE LANE**

WHEREAS, the Stanislaus Council of Governments (StanCOG) is the designated Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA), the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and the designated Council of Governments for Stanislaus County; and

WHEREAS, federal planning regulations require Metropolitan Planning Organizations to concur with the Transportation control Measure (TCM) substitution; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution has been prepared in full compliance with federal guidance; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution has been prepared to comply with Federal requirements through a collaborative process between the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District, the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the California Air Resources Board (CARB), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), the San Joaquin Valley Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), principal elected officials of general purpose local governments and their staffs, and public owner operators of mass transportation services acting through the Stanislaus Council of Governments forum and general public involvement; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution documentation includes quantification of the existing and substitute TCM that demonstrates the new TCM provides equal or greater emission reductions; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution documentation adequately addresses the implementation schedule requirements; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution documentation provides the required supporting evidence; and

WHEREAS, the TCM substitution documentation have been widely circulated and reviewed by Stanislaus Council of Governments advisory committees representing the technical and management staffs of the member agencies; representatives of other governmental agencies, including State and Federal; representatives of special interest groups; representatives of the private business sector; and residents of Stanislaus County; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was conducted on June 13, 2007 to hear and consider comments on the TCM substitution as well; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Stanislaus Council of Governments concurs with the TCM Substitution: Stanislaus County – existing River Road Bicycle Project and substitute Grayson Road Bike Lane.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 2007 meeting of the Stanislaus Council of Governments. A motion was made and seconded to adopt the foregoing Resolution. Motion carried and the Resolution was adopted.
